## THE CHALLENGE

The DLR Space Administration is looking for innovative ideas and concepts leading to improved technologies, processes and applications by transferring expertise between space and other sectors. This year's DLR Challenge focusses on:

- › Cost-cutting and time-saving approaches (e.g. lean production, qualifying of components, weight reduction)
- › Energy technologies (e.g. propulsion systems, energy storages)
- › Ideas related to space and health (e.g. sensor technology, biomedical sciences, material engineering)

The project ideas should have a technology readiness level of 1 to 6. This includes ideas from basic applied research up to technology demonstrators.

## THE PRIZE

Do you work for a company, in particular an SME, a university, or a non-university research institution? If so, we encourage you to enter the DLR Challenge.

- › Verifiable applications involving individual or joint proposals are eligible for funding from Germany's national space and innovation programme
- › Up to EUR 400,000 in possible funding for each project. This funding is subject to the general funding guidelines of the German Federal Government

## THE PARTNER

Acting on behalf of the Federal Government, the DLR Space Administration designs and implements Germany's Space Programme, which integrates all German space activities on the national and European level.
